
EVALUATION AND FEEDBACK

At the second question: "In your opinion, what have been the major achievements of the project thus far?"



In the eighth question from the survey "Have you observed any gaps or areas for improvement in terms of resource allocation or utilization within the project?", respondents noted several gaps and areas for improvement in resource allocation and utilization within the project. While the overall allocation of resources was deemed sufficient, there were observations of inefficiencies in resource utilization. Some respondents highlighted instances where resources could be better optimized or redistributed to enhance project outcomes. Additionally, there were suggestions for improved planning and monitoring mechanisms to ensure resources are allocated effectively and aligned with project goals.

The responses indicate varying perceptions regarding the extent to which the project has contributed to its intended beneficiaries or target audience. While a significant portion of respondents, comprising 65% of participants, expressed a high belief in the project's contribution (ratings of 4 or 5), indicating substantial impact and value delivered to beneficiaries, others took a more cautious stance. Approximately 25% of respondents rated the project's contribution as moderate (rating of 3), suggesting a perceived but perhaps not transformative impact. Meanwhile, a smaller percentage, accounting for 10% of participants, expressed lower confidence in the project's contribution (ratings of 1 or 2), indicating a need for improvement in delivering value to beneficiaries.
